Recall Summary

Canada 28 February 2023: Newmar is recalling 61 units of Newmar 2022-2023 Dutch Star Class A Motorhome, Essex Class A Motorhome, King Aire Class A Motorhome, London Aire Class A Motorhome, Mountain Aire Class A Motorhome, New Aire Class A Motorhome and Ventana Class A Motorhome because a software problem in the vehicle control module (ICM) could cause a sudden loss of power - crash risk.

United States 28 February 2023: Nissan North America Inc. is recalling 1,063 units of 2023 Ariya vehicles because the steering wheel bolt may have been tightened incorrectly or not installed - crash risk.

Canada 27 February 2023: Ford is recalling 55 units of 2023 Ford F-150 trucks because the front axle drive pinion could break and cause the truck to lose power to the front wheels - crash risk.

Canada 27 February 2023: Tesla is recalling 71 units of 2023 Tesla Model Y vehicles because the bolts that secure the second-row seat back frames may not have been properly tightened - injury risk.

United States 27 February 2023: Tesla Inc. is recalling 3,470 units of 2022-2023 Model Y vehicles because the bolts securing the second-row seat back frames may not have been securely tightened - injury risk.

United States 27 February 2023: Royal Enfield North America Limited is recalling 4,891 units of 2017-2021 Himalayan motorcycles because the salt used to treat the roads in the winter may corrode the brake callipers causing a decrease or total loss of brake function - crash risk.

Canada 24 February 2023: Ford is recalling 449 units of 2023 Ford Transit vehicles because the heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system may not work - crash risk.

Canada 24 February 2023: Prevost is recalling 80 units of 2019/2020/2023 Prevost H3-45 Coach and 2019-2023 Prevost H3-45 VIP vehicles because the fire sensor located in the engine compartment could fail - crash risk.

Canada 24 February 2023: BMW is recalling 64 units of 2023 BMW S1000RR motorcycles equipped with an optional milled hand brake lever because the fulcrum (pivot)

pin for the brake lever may not have been manufactured correctly which can result in a reduction in brake pressure that can cause reduced braking - crash risk.

Canada 24 February 2023: BMW is recalling 36 units of 2023 BMW 3 Series, 2022 4 Series and 2023 i4 vehicles because a programming error in the replacement BDC ECU could cause the automatic door locking function not to work - injury risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Xos Inc. is recalling 259 units of 2021-2022 SV05 Stepvan vehicles because the tire and loading information label has an incorrect front gross axle weight rating which could lead to an unintentional overloading of the vehicle - crash risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Prevost Car Inc. is recalling 555 units of 2018-2023 H3-45 motor coaches and H3-45 VIP motorhomes and 2019 H3-41 motor coaches because the Automatic Fire Suppression System (AFSS) optical fire sensor positioned in the engine compartment's lower region may corrode and malfunction - crash/injury risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Ford Motor Company is recalling 98,550 units of 2004-2006 Ranger vehicles that received replacement front passenger air bag inflators under a previous recall because the replacement frontal passenger air bag inflators may have been installed incorrectly - injury risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Ford Motor Company is recalling 240 units of 2023 F-150, Expedition and Lincoln Navigator vehicles because the front axle pinion may not have been heat-treated which can cause it to fracture - crash risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Ford Motor Company is recalling 4,804 units of 2023 Transit vehicles equipped with the Special Vehicle Operations Accessory Service Kit #1 or #2 with a High Specification Vehicle Interface Connector because when the accessory kit is installed, the auxiliary wire harness will disable the heating, air-conditioning and ventilation (HVAC) including the defrost and defog systems - crash risk.

United States 24 February 2023: BMW of North America LLC is recalling 394 units of 2023 S 1000 RR motorcycles

because the motorcycle hand brake lever may not function correctly, reducing brake performance - crash risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Gillig LLC is recalling 349 units of 2011-2021 Low Floor 29-foot CNG transit buses because the rear suspension lower control arm may fail - crash risk.

United States 24 February 2023: Thor Motor Coach is recalling 1,836 units of 2018-2021 Hurricane and Windsport recreational vehicles because the driver and front passenger overhead cabinets may detach - crash/injury risk.

Canada 23 February 2023: Navistar is recalling 2,003 units of 2022-2024 International HV and International MV trucks equipped with an automatic transmission because when the engine RPM increases for the stationary power take off (PTO), it can overcome the parking brake if the transmission is in drive or reverse gear - crash risk.

Canada 23 February 2023: Fiat Chrysler Automobiles is recalling 18,163 units of 2021-2023 Dodge Durango vehicles because the rear spoiler could hit the body when opening and closing the liftgate which could damage the spoiler and cause it to detach from the vehicle - crash risk.

Canada 23 February 2023: Fiat Chrysler Automobiles is recalling 7,464 units of 2020-2023 Jeep Gladiator and 2018-2023 Jeep Wrangler because under certain conditions, the clutch pressure plate could overheat and break - fire/injury risk.

United States 23 February 2023: BMW of North America LLC is recalling 120 units 2023 330i, 330i xDrive, M340i, M340i xDrive, M3, 330e, 330e xDrive, 430i Convertible, 430i xDrive, M440i, 2022-2023 430i, 430i xDrive, M440i xDrive, i4 eDrive40 and i4 M50 vehicles because during a service visit, a replacement electronic control unit (ECU) may have been installed with incorrect programming which can cause the automatic door locking (ADL) function to not lock the doors as intended - injury risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Braun Ambulances is recalling 64 units of 2022 Demers ambulances because the rear step of the ambulance may fail under weight due to incorrect welding - injury risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Thor Motor Coach is recalling 1,969 units of 2015-2023 Palazzo recreational vehicles because the front lower cap brackets that support the front fiberglass panel may become loose and detach from the vehicle while in motion - crash risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Navistar Inc. is recalling 27,972 units of 2022-2024 International HV, International MV trucks and 2022-2023 IC Bus TC commercial buses because when the parking brake is applied, the automatic transmission is still in drive or reverse position, and the stationary power take-off (PTO) switch is engaged by the operator, the engine may rev and overcome the parking brake's ability to keep the vehicle from moving - crash/injury risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Fiat Chrysler Automobiles is recalling 69,201 units of 2018-2023 Jeep Wrangler and 2020-2023 Jeep Gladiator vehicles equipped with manual transmissions because the clutch pressure plate may overheat and fracture - crash risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Fiat Chrysler Automobiles is recalling 139,019 units of 2021-2023 Dodge Durango vehicles because the rear spoiler may not be aligned properly with the roof, resulting in damage to the spoiler during liftgate use - crash risk.

United States 23 February 2023: Navistar Inc. is recalling 4,199 units of 2018-2021 International HV, 2019-2021 International RH, 2019-2022 International MV and 2022 International HX vehicles because a software error in the Body Control Module (BCM) may allow the vehicle to overcome the park brake during power-take-off (PTO) operation - crash/injury risk.

Canada 22 February 2023: General Motors is recalling one 2023 Cadillac XT5 vehicle because the right-front axle shaft may not have been manufactured properly - crash/injury risk.

Canada 22 February 2023: Toyota is recalling 794 units of 2022-2023 Toyota Tundra trucks because a software problem could cause the instrument cluster display to go blank while driving - crash risk.

United States 22 February 2023: Lordstown EV Corp is

recalling 19 units of 2023 Endurance electric pickup trucks because the high-voltage cable between the inverter and motor may experience a fault that causes a loss of drive power and the vehicle cannot be restarted once turned off - crash risk.

United States 22 February 2023: Roadtrek Inc. is recalling 54 units of 2021-2022 Zion, Chase, Zion Slumber, Play, Play Slumber, Zion SRT and Play SRT recreational vehicles, equipped with certain SDS2 2-burner drop-in cooktops because the internal aluminium burner tubes that connect to the gas valves may fracture and cause a gas leak - fire risk.

United States 22 February 2023: Rivian Automotive LLC is recalling 12,716 units of 2022 R1T and R1S vehicles because a faulty automatic locking retractor (ALR) sensor in the front passenger seat belt system may incorrectly report as ON when it is actually OFF causing the suppression or improper deployment of the air bag - injury risk.

United States 22 February 2023: Toyota Motor Engineering & Manufacturing is recalling 8,989 units of 2022-2023 Tundra and Tundra Hybrid vehicles because a software error in the combination meter's electronic control unit (ECU) may cause the Instrument Panel LCD display to go blank - crash risk.

United States 21 February 2023: Par Nado Inc. is recalling 1,098 units of 2021-2024 Alto R1713, R1723, F1743, F2114, A2124 and F2414 travel trailers equipped with certain SDS2 2-burner drop-in cooktops because the internal aluminium burner tubes that connect to the gas valves may fracture and cause a gas leak - fire risk.

United States 21 February 2023: Nissan North America Inc. is recalling 17 units of 2023 Infiniti QX60 vehicles because the second-row adjustable seat may extend past the intended rear stopper point and may be difficult to move, become stuck, or fail to lock in the correct position - injury risk.

Canada 20 February 2023: Jayco is recalling 222 units of 2022-2023 Entegra Coach Accolade, Anthem, Aspire, Esteem, Expanse, Odyssey, Reatta, Reatta XL, Vision, Vision XL, 2022-2023 Jayco Alante Motorhome, Embark, Greyhawk Motorhome, Melbourne, Precept Motorhome,

Redhawk Motorhome, Seneca Motorhome and Solstice motorhomes because the compliance label on certain motorhomes is missing the gross axle weight rating (GAWR) for the rear axle - crash risk.

United States 20 February 2023: Polaris Inc. is recalling 163 units of 2022-2023 Slingshot R, Slingshot S with Technology Package 1, Slingshot SL, Slingshot SLR and Slingshot S motorcycles because the alternator may have been improperly heat-treated during manufacturing - fire risk.

United States 20 February 2023: Jayco Inc. is recalling 2,467 units of 2022-2023 Entegra Accolade, Accolade XL, Anthem, Aspire, Cornerstone, Emblem, Esteem, Expanse, Expanse LI, Odyssey, Qwest, Reatta, Reatta XL, Jayco Alante, Greyhawk, Greyhawk Prestige, Melbourne, Melbourne Prestige, Precept, Precept Prestige, Redhawk, Redhawk SE, Seneca, Seneca Prestige and Seneca XT recreational vehicles because the certification labels may be missing the rear Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) - crash risk.

United States 20 February 2023: Tiffin Motorhomes Inc. is recalling 243 units of 2021-2022 Cahaba recreational vehicles because the rear Sumo Springs may be the wrong size and the front Sumo Springs may have been installed in an incorrect location - crash risk.

United States 20 February 2023: Daimler Trucks North America LLC is recalling 60,604 units of 2019-2021 Freightliner 108SD, 114SD, 122SD, Columbia, Coronado, Business Class M2 and 2020 Freightliner Cascadia vehicles because the drag link taper joint may not have been tightened sufficiently and could come loose, resulting in a complete separation of the drag link from the steering arm - crash risk.

United States 20 February 2023: Aluminum Trailer Company is recalling 757 units of 2021-2023 Toyhauler and Quest trailers equipped with certain SDS2 2-Burner Drop-in Cooktops because the internal aluminium burner tubes that connect to the gas valves may fracture and cause a gas leak - fire risk.

Canada 17 February 2023: Pierce is recalling 15 units of 2018-2023 Pierce Arrow XT, Enforcer, Impel and Velocity

fire trucks because the hinge peg for the basket handrail on the aerial platform could break - injury risk.

Canada 17 February 2023: BMW is recalling 258 units of 2023 BMW 2 Series, 8 Series and Z4 vehicles because a software problem could allow you to close the windows and roof without the digital key inside the vehicle - injury risk.

Canada 17 February 2023: Hyundai is recalling 6,900 units of 2021-2023 Genesis G80, 2023 Genesis GV60, 2022-2023 Genesis GV70 and 2021-2023 Genesis GV80 vehicles because there may be a problem with the front seat belt pretensioners - injury risk.

United States 17 February 2023: Pierce Manufacturing is recalling 64 units 2018-2023 Velocity, Impel, Enforcer, and Arrow XT 110-foot aerial trucks because when the aerial platform is extended to its maximum angle, the platform mounting bracket may interfere with the basket handrail hinge peg and cause the handrail to detach from the basket - injury risk.

United States 17 February 2023: Daimler Vans USA LLC is recalling 52,993 units of 2019-2020 Mercedes-Benz Sprinter VS30 and Freightliner Sprinter VS30 vehicles because the heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) blower motor circuit may be inadequate which can allow the wiring harness to overheat - fire risk.

United States 17 February 2023: BMW of North America LLC is recalling 3,193 units of 2023 8 Series Coupe (840i, 840i xDrive, M850i xDrive, M8), 8 Series Convertible (840i, 840i xDrive, M850i xDrive, M8), 8 Series Gran Coupe (840i, 840i xDrive, M850i xDrive, M8, Alpine B8 xDrive), 2 Series Coupe (230i, 230i xDrive, M240i xDrive, M2) and 2022-2023 Z4 sDrive30i, Z4 M40i vehicles because when the digital key is removed from the vehicle, the Electronic Control Unit (ECU) software may still allow the power windows and sunroof to be closed - injury risk.

Canada 16 February 2023: Honda is recalling one 2023 Honda CR-V vehicle because the front passenger's seat frame may not have been properly welded - injury risk.

Canada 16 February 2023: Jayco is recalling 7 units of 2023 Jayco Redhawk Motorhomes because the wrong seat belt brackets may have been installed on the dinette seats -

injury risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Jayco Inc. is recalling 2,845 units of 2019-2023 Entegra Launch, Launch LE, Qwest, Jayco Melbourne, Melbourne Prestige, Terrain and Terrain LE motorhomes because the guide bushing on the parking pawl may fatigue which can cause the parking pawl not to engage and result in a vehicle rollaway - **crash risk**.

United States 16 February 2023: Nissan North America Inc. is recalling 712,458 units of 2014-2020 Rogue and 2017-2022 Rogue Sport vehicles equipped with a jack-knife style ignition key because the jack-knife key may collapse into a folded position while driving - crash/injury risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Nikola Corporation is recalling 137 units of 2022 TRE BEV vehicles because the shaft locking screw on the brake pedal may be missing or may not be fully threaded which can cause the brake pedal to detach - crash risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Jayco Inc. is recalling 20 units of 2023 Redhawk SE motorhomes because the dinette rear and forward-facing seat belts have the incorrect brackets installed which can cause the brackets to loosen - injury risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Electra Meccanica Vehicles Corp is recalling 428 units of 2021-2023 Solo vehicles because a defect in the motor controller and inverter or the battery controller may cause the electric motor to shut down and cause a sudden loss of drive power - crash risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Continental Tire the Americas LLC is recalling 3 units of General Altimax RT43 because they contain a tire identification number (TIN) that is missing the 3-digit plant code and the 6-symbol manufacturer's identification mark - crash risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Honda is recalling 98 units of 2023 CR-V vehicles because the front passenger seat back frame may not have been welded properly which can cause the seat back position to fail in the event of a crash - injury risk.

United States 16 February 2023: Hyundai Motor

America is recalling 65,517 units of 2020-2023 Genesis GV80, 2021-2023 Genesis G80, 2022-2023 Genesis GV70 and 2023 Genesis GV60 vehicles because in the event of a crash, the front driver-side and/or passenger-side seat belt pretensioners may explode upon deployment - injury risk.

Canada 15 February 2023: PACCAR is recalling 410 units of 2022-2024 Kenworth T280, T380, T480 and Peterbilt 537 and 538 trucks because when the brake pedal is fully applied and released quickly, the pedal plunger could jam or disconnect from the brake valve - crash risk.

Canada 15 February 2023: Audi is recalling 78 units of 2022-2023 Audi A8 and S8 vehicles because the occupant protection flap within the passenger-front airbag module may not have been folded properly - injury risk.

Canada 15 February 2023: Keystone is recalling 226 units of 2021-2023 Keystone Carbon, Fuzion, Impact and Raptor RV trailers because the fuel station controller could fail - fire risk.

Canada 15 February 2023: Jayco is recalling 168 units of 2019-2023 Entegra Coach Launch, Jayco Melbourne, Jayco Melbourne Prestige, Jayco Qwest and Jayco Terrain motorhomes because in certain conditions, the motorhome could roll-away after placing the transmission in the "P" (Park) position if the parking brake is not set - injury/crash risk.

United States 15 February 2023: New Flyer of America Inc. is recalling 219 units of 2021-2022 XE35, 2021-2023 XE40 and 2021-2022 XE60 electric buses because one or more battery packs may accumulate liquid in the battery pack enclosure - fire risk.

United States 15 February 2023: PACCAR Incorporated is recalling 8,008 units of 2021-2024 Kenworth T280, T380, T480, Peterbilt 536, 537 and 548 vehicles because when the brake pedal is fully applied and then released rapidly, the pedal plunger that connects the brake pedal to the brake valve may become disconnected, causing the service brakes to fail - crash risk.

United States 15 February 2023: Tesla Inc. is recalling 362,758 units of 2016-2023 Model S, Model X, 2017-

2023 Model 3 and 2020-2023 Model Y vehicles equipped with Full Self-Driving Beta (FSD Beta) software or pending installation because the FSD Beta system may allow the vehicle to act unsafe around intersections, such as traveling straight through an intersection while in a turn-only lane, entering a stop sign-controlled intersection without coming to a complete stop, or proceeding into an intersection during a steady yellow traffic signal without due caution. In addition, the system may respond insufficiently to changes in posted speed limits or not adequately account for the driver's adjustment of the vehicle's speed to exceed posted speed limits - crash risk.

United States 15 February 2023: Keystone RV Company is recalling 5,564 units of 2021-2023 Carbon, Fuzion, Impact and Raptor travel trailers because the fuel station controller may fail - fire risk.

United States 15 February 2023: Suzuki Motor USA LLC is recalling 2,552 units of 2022 GSX1300RRQ/ZM2 (Hayabusa) motorcycles because an incorrect position of the front brake master cylinder primary port could cause the port to become blocked and result in a gap between the front brake pad and discs - crash risk.

United States 15 February 2023: Volkswagen Group of America Inc. is recalling 12,100 units of 2009-2015 Q7 vehicles because the Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) listed on the certification label is incorrect which can allow the vehicle to be overloaded - crash risk.

United States 15 February 2023: Volkswagen Group of America Inc. is recalling 1,047 units of 2022-2023 S8 and A8 vehicles because during air bag assembly, the front-passenger occupant protection flap of the air bag may not have been folded correctly - injury risk.

Canada 14 February 2023: BraunAbility is recalling 41 units of 1997-2023 BraunAbility Turny Evo Seat because on vehicles equipped with an aftermarket BraunAbility Turny Evo seat, the optional anchors for attaching a child or booster seat may not have been welded correctly - injury risk.

Canada 14 February 2023: Truck Outfitters Canada Inc. is recalling 150 units of 2010-2023 Truck Outfitters Canada Inc. Deck Body and Dump Body vehicles because they

were built with reflective tape instead of the required reflex reflectors - crash risk.

Canada 14 February 2023: Tesla is recalling 20,667 units of 2018-2022 Tesla Model 3, 2016-2023 Model S, 2016-2023 Model X and 2020-2022 Model Y because in certain traffic situations, when the FSD Beta advanced driver assistance feature is engaged, the vehicle may perform manoeuvres that break certain traffic laws if the driver doesn't intervene and take control - crash risk.

Canada 14 February 2023: BMW is recalling 3,882 units of 2022-2023 BMW IX and 2023 X1 vehicles because the driver-front airbag may not inflate correctly in a crash-injury risk.

Canada 14 February 2023: Daimler Truck North America is recalling 420 units of 2022-2024 Freightliner Business Class M2, Cascadia, 2022-2024 Western Star 4700, 47X and 49X trucks because the tail lamps do not turn on when the daytime running lamps (DRLs) are on - crash risk.

United States 14 February 2023: Bendix Commercial Vehicle Systems LLC is recalling 836 units of Intellipark Towing Park Brake Modules (PVM) because the PVM may become stuck and fail to move into the park position when the park switch is activated - crash risk.

United States 14 February 2023: BMW of North America LLC is recalling 15,803 units of 2022-2023 iX xDrive40, iX xDrive50, iX M60 and 2022-2023 X1 xDrive28i vehicles because the front driver's air bag may have been manufactured incorrectly and may not deploy as intended during a crash - injury risk.

United States 14 February 2023: Subaru of America Inc. is recalling 8,413 units of 2019-2022 Crosstrek Hybrid vehicles because the harness terminal that supplies low-voltage power from the converter to the 12-Volt battery may corrode and break, preventing the 12-Volt battery from charging - crash risk.

Canada 13 February 2023: Safari Condo is recalling is recalling 1,098 units of 2021-2024 Safari Condo Alto A-Series, Alto F-Series, Alto R-Series, 2020-2022 Safari Condo LDX, LX, MX, XL Flex and XL Plus RV trailers and motorhomes because the aluminium tubes that connect the

gas valves to the cooktop burners could crack - fire risk.

Canada 13 February 2023: Lakota is recalling 10 units of 2019-2023 Lakota Bighorn trailers because the vaulted ceiling over the bed in the gooseneck area wasn't installed correctly - injury risk.

Canada 13 February 2023: Ford is recalling 48 units of 2023 Ford Bronco, Explorer and F-150 because there could be a loose bolt inside the transmission - injury/crash risk.

Canada 13 February 2023: Ford is recalling 107 units of 2023 Ford Transit vehicles because the fuel tank vent valve may not have been properly welded to the fuel tank - fire risk.

Canada 13 February 2023: Ford is recalling 20 units of 2023 Ford F-150 trucks because a problem with the instrument panel cover may cause the passenger-front airbag not to inflate properly in a crash - injury risk.

United States 13 February 2023: Lakota Corporation is recalling 445 units of 2019-2023 Bighorn trailers because the trey ceiling above the bed may not have been installed correctly and may detach - injury risk.

United States 13 February 2023: Braun Corporation is recalling 153 units of child seat weldments sold as accessory parts to the BraunAbility Turny Seat, because the child restraint lower anchors may have been manufactured with improper welds - injury risk.

United States 13 February 2023: Proterra Operating Company Inc. is recalling 274 units of 2020-2022 35" Catalyst, 35" ZX5 and 40" ZX5 vehicles because the windshield wiper motors may operate intermittently or may fail to operate - crash risk.

United States 13 February 2023: Subaru of America Inc. is recalling 130 units of 2004-2005 Impreza and WRX vehicles that received replacement front passenger air bag inflators under a previous recall because the replacement air bag inflators may have been installed incorrectly - injury risk.

Canada 10 February 2023: Daimler Truck North America is recalling 20,527 units of 2017-2023 Freightliner Cascadia,

2017-2023 Western Star 47X and 4X trucks because the brake modulator valves could corrode - crash risk.

Canada 10 February 2023: Thor Motor Coach is recalling 39 units of 2022-2023 Thor Motor Coach Rize and Scope motorhomes because the retractable awning could extend on its own while driving - crash risk.

United States 10 February 2023: Gillig LLC is recalling 487 units of SAF Holland suspension torque rods, sold as replacement parts, because they may be incompatible and cause damage to the vehicle wiring harness and certain safety-related circuits such as anti-lock or service brakes, stability control, exterior lighting equipment, power steering or engine and transmission control modules - crash risk.

United States 10 February 2023: Bendix Commercial Vehicle Systems LLC is recalling 10,425 units of Foot Brake Valve Assemblies, model Medium-Duty Vehicle Pedal A, because when the brake pedal is fully applied and then released rapidly, the pedal plunger that connects the brake pedal to the brake valve may become disconnected causing the brakes to fail - crash risk.

United States 10 February 2023: Ford Motor Company is recalling 321 units of 2023 F-150 vehicles because the instrument panel top cover on the passenger-side may prevent the air bag from deploying as intended - injury risk.
