

#### **Recall Summary**

**Canada 31 March 2023:** Demers is recalling 64 units of 2022-2023 Demers MX Series Ambulance and MXP Series Ambulance because the step under the rear doors may not have been properly welded which could cause it to fail when used - injury risk.

**Canada 31 March 2023:** Rivian is recalling 9 units of 2022-2023 Rivian R1S vehicles because the backup lamps may not be visible from some viewing angles - crash risk.

**Canada 31 March 2023**: Gulf Stream Coach is recalling 55 units of 2023-2024 Gulf Stream BT Cruiser and Gulf Stream Conquest motorhomes because a problem with the latch for the entry door could cause it to fail - injury risk.

**Canada 31 March 2023:** Altec Industries is recalling 2 units of 2015-2023 Altec DM47 digger derricks with a dual pole rack system because a weld could be missing on the rear pole rack - injury risk.

**Canada 31 March 2023:** Forest River is recalling 6 units of 2023 East to West Della Terra RV trailers because they were equipped with safety chains that are not strong enough - crash risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Tesla Inc. is recalling 422 units of 2018-2019 Model 3 vehicles because the front suspension lateral link fasteners may loosen, allowing the lateral link to separate from the sub-frame - crash risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Kia America Inc. is recalling 51,568 units of 2022 and 2023 Carnival vehicles because the auto-reverse feature for the power sliding doors (PSD) may not activate in all situations - injury risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Rivian Automotive LLC is recalling 5,030 units of 2022-2023 R1S vehicles because the reverse light beam may not be visible from certain angles - crash risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Forest River Inc. is recalling 98 units of 2023 East to West Della Terra and Silver Lake travel trailers because the drawbar assembly containing the A-frame and safety chains may be insufficient for the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) and could potentially break - crash risk.

United States 31 March 2023: Forest River Inc. is recalling

70 units of 2023 Cherokee CKT36FBOP Travel Trailers because the safety chains may be insufficient for the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) listed on the federal placard which can allow the trailer to detach - crash risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Gulf Stream Coach Inc. is recalling 557 units of 2023-2024 Conquest and BT Cruiser Class C Mini Motor Homes because the entry door latch may fail and not allow entry or exit - injury risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Mercedes-Benz USA LLC is recalling 3 units of 2023 AMG CLA 45 vehicles because the tires may leak air - crash risk.

**United States 31 March 2023:** Great Dane Trailers is recalling 562 units of 2023 Champion Dry Van trailers because the wheel hubs may have an insufficient amount of lubrication which could cause the hub bearings to fail - crash risk.

United States 31 March 2023: Winnebago Industries Inc. is recalling 1,180 units of 2021-2023 Ekko motorhomes because the 12-Volt charging system may have improperly routed wires and loose electrical connections which can overload the electrical circuits and cause damage to electrical components, including the auxiliary alternator fire risk.

**Canada 30 March 2023:** Jayco is recalling 57 units of 2022-2023 Entegra Coach Anthem, Aspire, Cornerstone, Reatta, Reatta XL and Jayco Embark motorhomes because a software problem in the vehicle control module could cause a sudden loss of power - crash risk.

**Canada 30 March 2023:** Honda is recalling 79 units of 2023 Honda Civic Type-R models because the driver's seat frame may not have been properly welded - injury risk.

**Canada 30 March 2023:** Spartan Fire is recalling 4 units of 20220-2023 Spartan Gladiator and Spartan Metro Star fire trucks because the retaining clips (keepers) may not have been installed correctly on the steer axle nuts - crash risk.

of 2022 Entegra Coach Qwest motorhomes because the wiring harnesses for the swivel-seats may have been incorrectly installed and may become damaged which can cause the front side air bags not to deploy as intended - injury risk.

**United States 30 March 2023:** Jaguar Land Rover North America LLC is recalling one 2023 Land Rover Range Rover vehicle because a gasket on the turbo oil drainpipe may be incorrectly installed or missing which can result in an oil leak - fire risk.

**United States 30 March 2023:** Jaguar Land Rover North America LLC is recalling 2,881 units of 2019-2021 Land Rover Range Rover PHEV and 2019-2022 Land Rover Range Rover Sport PHEV vehicles because the water pump pulley drive belt may become damaged or detach which can allow the engine to overheat - fire risk.

**United States 30 March 2023:** Altec Industries Inc. is recalling 631 units of 2016-2022 DM, DH, DC, DL, D2000, D3000, D4000 series digger derricks and AM55 aerial devices because the base of the rear pole rack may be missing a weld - injury risk.
